

Professional Biography of Dr. Asib Ahmed

Dr. Asib Ahmed is an Assistant Professor in the Department of Geography and Environment, University of Dhaka. He has gained more than 20 years of expertise through a career path that included Research Officer, Lecturer, Assistant Professor, Moderator of Environment Club, and Country Representatives of international research organizations. Dr. Ahmed holds a Bachelor's and a Master's degrees in Geography and Environment from University of Dhaka, Bangladesh. He achieved his PhD degree from the University of Leeds, United Kingdom.



Dr. Ahmed's depth and breadth of experience in the field of earth sciences prepared him well for his current passion. His research focuses on increasing knowledge about global environmental change phenomena, coastal land dynamics and land susceptibility to erosion. It involves: (i) modelling environmental changes; (ii) eliciting climate uncertainties (iii) evaluating science-people-policy nexus.
